Course Locations

Course #1 (Cardiac Ridge) the road behind the first cabin, east of lodge.

Course #2 (Stickbow Alley) left of the triple chairlift, east side of lodge.

Course #3 (Ironman) starts at target #13 on Course #3.

Course #4 (NEW Canadian Course) Starts a short way up Elm Hollow, (easy ski trail at bottom of triple chairlift) follows trails and logging roads. Ends at the beginning of the Iron Man Course.
